Farmer's Market at Circle Square Commons Town Square

OCALA, FLA. – The Town Square at Circle Square Commons – developed by On Top of the World Communities – takes on a nostalgic air each week with the offerings of local and regional growers and artisans at a farmer's market on the square.

Each month, on Thursdays and the fourth Saturday, multi-colored, hand-painted carts of produce, baked goods, plants, handmade soaps and other offerings fill The Town Square, drawing hundreds of shoppers from On Top of the World and the surrounding greater Ocala area. Moreover, there are free, weekly cooking demonstrations by On Top of the World chefs. The oldest continuously operated farmer's market in Marion County, the weekly event attracts dozens of vendors offering a wide selection of goods, including exotic pastas, cheeses, British meat pies, handmade jewelry, seafood ... and different hand-crafted items each week.

The Farmer's Market is open 8 a.m.-noon in the spring and summer, and 9 a.m.-1 p.m. during the fall and winter.
